IMPETIGO (School Sores)

Once more, there have been reported cases of this infection recently. This condition is highly contagious and children must be excluded from school until treatment has begun and any remaining lesions are completely covered with waterproof sticking plaster. Treatment is usually in the form of antibiotics.

If you suspect that your child has School Sores, please seek medical advice.
